## Athlete Eligibility

All athletes must be registered in the Union Internationale de Pentathlon Modern (UIPM) and have a UIPM license.

Athletes must have signed the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

## Qualification System

Date	Event	Qualified athletes
May 26 <sup>th</sup> thru June 08 <sup>th</sup> , 2018	South American Games in Cochabamba	All attending countries will have the right to enter one (1) athlete for each event.
July 19 <sup>th</sup> thru August 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 2018	Central American and Caribbean Games	All attending countries will have the right to enter one (1) athlete for each event.
November 8 <sup>th</sup> thru 11 <sup>th</sup> , 2018	Pan American Championship	The remaining places will go to the nations in the order of placing of their second best-placed athlete at Pan American Championship.
November 8 <sup>th</sup> thru 11 <sup>th</sup> , 2018	Pan American Championship	Any remaining places will go to the nations in the order of placing of their third best-placed athlete at the Pan American Championship.



Because USA does not take part in the first two Games (South American Games and Central American and Caribbean Games), they will have the right to enter one (1) athlete per event.

If, for duly justified reasons, a country cannot participate in the South American Games or Central American and Caribbean Games, the MPPC may adopt the same criteria used for the USA and CAN.

Peru, as host country, will have the right to enter two (2) athletes by event minimum to ensure their participation in the individuals and relays events.

## Confirmation of Quota Places

Following the completion of the quota allocation based on the system described above, the Pan American Confederation (PC) will notify Panam Sports and each NOC/NF of the number of quota places that have been obtained by December 15, 2018.

By January 30, 2019, at the latest, the NOC/NF shall advise the PC the number of quota places that the NOC/NF will enter in each event.

## Reallocation of Unused Quota Places

The MPPC will reallocate unused quota places to the NOC of the next best-ranked athlete at the 2018 Pan American Championship who has not yet qualified.

This process will be completed by February 15, 2019.
