Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form.

All athletes must be registered with the International Modern Pentathlon Union (UIPM) and hold a license issued by the UIPM.

Qualification system

As the host country, Peru will be entitled to enter a minimum of two (2) athletes per gender to ensure its participation in the individual and relay events. Peru may qualify a third athlete at the 2026 Pan American Championships.

Gold medalists who have directly qualified at the 2025 Buenos Aires Pan American Championships for the 2027 Lima Pan American Games will not be eligible to secure another spot for their NOC; however, another athlete may compete for an additional spot through the Lima 2027 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

If athletes who qualified at the 2025 Buenos Aires Pan American Championships do not wish to compete at the 2027 Lima Pan American Games in the category for which they qualified, that spot will be forfeited and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete

All countries will be entitled to directly qualify one (1) athlete per gender and up to two (2) additional athletes at the 2026 Pan American Championships.

Places for the second and third athletes from each country will be awarded based on the ranking of their respective third athletes at the Pan American Championships, until the quota is completed.

The ranking criteria for the best second and third athletes to qualify for the 2027 Lima Pan American Games will be based on finishing order and the total score from all Modern Pentathlon disciplines (Fencing, Obstacle Course, Swimming, Laser Run).

All athletes representing the NOCs at the Lima 2027 Pan American Games must have previously participated in an international Modern Pentathlon event in 2025, 2026, or 2027. This requirement is MANDATORY.

Confirmation of quotas

No later than July 22, 2026, CPPM will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified.

No later than July 29, 2026, the NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and to CPPM the places they will use.

Reallocation of unused quotas

In necessary, no later than August 5, 2026, CPPM will reallocate unused quotas to the next best ranked NOC that has not yet qualified.

No later than August 12, 2026, the NOCs that received reallocated quotas must confirm their participation.

Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games Qualification

In the Pan American Games, the top five (5) athletes per gender will obtain direct qualification for the LA2028 Olympic Games, for a total of 10 athletes with direct qualification.
